Dear Parents/Carers,

Absence from school/nursery

Please can I remind all parents/carers about the need to contact school regarding a pupil absence. Please either telephone school or complete an absence form on the school website for <u>all</u> pupils on the first day of absence. Please confirm all absences reported by telephone with either a letter or an absence form either via the school website or by filling in a paper form that can be found in all the classrooms.

<u>Safeguarding Issues</u>

Please do not use the school corridors or shared areas as thoroughfares through school. If you need to go to the school office from the reception classes, please leave by the usual door and walk round to reception.

Please leave the school grounds promptly on a morning to enable the gates to be closed/locked for safeguarding purposes.

Playground Safety

Please can I ask that you remind your child about using the playground equipment safely. This message has been given to the children by the staff and will be reiterated at playtimes but your assistance with this would be much appreciated. Please remember, the equipment should not be used by **any** children at the beginning or end of the school day.

P.E. Kit

P.E. kit should be the following:- Indoor – navy shorts, white t-shirt, plimsolls
Outdoor – As above plus a navy tracksuit.

Only stud earrings can be worn in school and must be removed or covered with micropore tape for p.e. Hair accessories must be kept to a minimum.

Sun Protection

As the weather improves, please ensure your child has had sun cream applied before school and a sunhat and school water bottle are available for them to use during the day.
